This second session of fall clubs will run from Monday, November 2 through Friday, December 18; Clubs will not meet on the Monday and Tuesday leading up to our Thanksgiving Break, which runs from November 25-27. This club session will take us all the way to our winter break.

Students will have a choice of projects that represent traditions celebrated in the past and present, and from every continent (except Antarctica!) around the globe. Create a rangoli from the Indian Festival of Lights. Design a Thanksgiving or winter wreath. Weave a kwanza placemat or table topper from fabric of your choosing.

When is winter solstice? What is a yule log? Using only items found in nature we will explore the history of these traditions and stamp note cards that can be given as a gift or used to pen notes to friends. Max of 8 students.

Children will learn and improve their floor and balance beam skills from the comfort of their own home. Watch in amazement how we transform every day household objects into gymnastics equipment that'll help each child improve on their skills at their own pace. A rolled up towel becomes a great balance beam or a pillow can become a soft cushion for rolling.

The camp is led by lead instructor and owner of Learning Ladder Gymnastics Miss Jen. Jen has been coaching gymnastics since 2003 and has several years of classroom experience teaching. She also recently served as Physical Education instructor for HMS' Childrens' House.





Registrations and Waivers

Enrollment & COVID-19

All clubs are filled on a firstcome, first-served basis with social distancing implemented. In order for your student to be enrolled, complete all sections of the registration and submit full payment. Registrations received once clubs begin will not be prorated unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Should there be a positive case of COVID-19 by one of the participants or leaders of a club, we will follow the procedures set forth by the school's policy.

Class Cancellations

If school is closed due to weather or other emergency, class is automatically cancelled. Absences on the part of the child are forfeited; absences on the part of the instructor or contractor will be made up via make-up date, extended time during a future meeting date, or credited. In the case of a snow day, there is no rescheduling due to weather cancellations. unless otherwise stated. We will make every effort to reschedule clubs due to rainy/cold weather.

Withdrawals and Refunds

If withdrawal from a club occurs a week before the Session begins, a refund or credit will be considered. There are no refunds or credits once clubs have begun.

If a written request is made at least seven days prior to the beginning of the club session, a refund can be issued minus a \$35 processing fee. If a club does not meet the minimum enrollment requirements and is cancelled by HMS, a full refund will be issued.
